

Recreation Building Available For Rentable Space

The Washington Township Committee strives to provide a comprehensive park system, recreation programs and special events for the entire community. Last year in collaboration with the Recreation Committee and the Department of Public Works the Recreation Building at 33 Little Philadelphia Road is now available for rental space.

The Recreation Building has a programmable keyless entryway allowing both a.m. and p.m. access seven (7) days per week with a meeting room available with tables and chairs to accommodate up to eighty (80) people. The room is also provided with a kitchenette which includes ample countertop space, a sink and a small refrigerator. The space is ideal for birthday parties, bridal showers, business meetings, clubs and non-profit organizations making it a perfect venue regardless of the weather.

The Recreation Building is located within the 70 Acres of Meadow Breeze Park giving access to the entire Park. The Parks and Recreation Building is directly adjacent to the historical Morris Canal and in close proximity to playground equipment, swings and recreation fields that would accommodate games of baseball, softball and soccer. This location also gives access to the entire Meadow Breeze Park Complex which includes many scenic views along the Brass Castle Creek promoting both active and passive recreation including over two miles of paved walking trails with benches and an outdoor pavilion. Also included within the park complex are several playground equipment areas, basketball courts, hardball and softball fields, a football field, lacrosse/soccer fields, horseshoe pits, two volleyball courts and tennis courts.
