PROCLAMATION TO RECOGNIZE SPECIAL OLYMPIC ATHLETE AMY NOCTOR

WHEREAS, Every four years Special Olympics conducts a National Summer Games in the United States and in June of 2014 Washington Township native Amy Noctor was one of 3500 athletes from around the country to participate in the Special Olympics USA Games held in the State of New Jersey which was the most dynamic, innovative and largest national Games to date and a historic, life and perception-changing event; and

WHEREAS, To qualify for an inaugural triathlon Amy needed to win a gold medal in a long distance swimming event and had to pass an interview with a New Jersey Special Olympics Administrator; and

WHEREAS, 34 athletes participated in the Triathlon in which both male and female athletes started the race together and Amy was the fifth person to cross the finish line but was the first female making her the overall female winner and Amy received and came home with a gold medal for her hard work.
