MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

- It was discussed that the Washington Township Environmental Commission would take on the new role of educating the public regarding the Pohatcong Valley Superfund Site, especially since the Warren County Environmental Commission is no longer an operating Commission.

Contact will also be made with other Townships within the Superfund area, in order to work together in educating people living within the boundaries of the site.
